

Full Warranty on the PerfectPitchARM™ Springs

This Full Warranty covers the PerfectPitchARM™ Springs supplied with the PerfectPitchARM™ Machine purchased from Erwin Sports, LLC.

What does this full warranty cover? This Full Warranty covers any defects in your PerfectPitchARM™ Springs.

What will we do to correct problems? Erwin Sports, LLC will replace the PerfectPitchARM™ Springs at no charge, using new parts.

How long does the coverage last? The Full Warranty Period is for the lifetime of the purchaser.

What does this limited warranty not cover? This Full Warranty does not cover any other parts of the PerfectPitchARM™ Machine.

What do you have to do? To obtain warranty service, you must contact us and provide your order number.

Limited Warranty on the PerfectPitchARM™ Machine

This Limited Warranty covers the PerfectPitchARM™ Machine (see Springs warranty above) from Erwin Sports, LLC.

What does this limited warranty cover? This Limited Warranty covers any defects in material or workmanship under normal use during the Warranty Period. During the Warranty Period, Erwin Sports, LLC will repair or replace, at no charge, products or parts of a product that proves defective because of improper material or workmanship, under normal use and maintenance.

What will we do to correct problems? Erwin Sports, LLC will either repair the PerfectPitchARM™ Machine at no charge, using new or refurbished replacement parts.

How long does the coverage last? The Warranty Period for the PerfectPitchARM™ Machine purchased from Erwin Sports, LLC is two (2) years from the date of purchase. A replacement PerfectPitchARM™ Machine or part assumes the remaining warranty of the original PerfectPitchARM™ Machine.

What does this limited warranty not cover? This Limited Warranty does not cover any problem that is caused by: conditions, malfunctions or damage not resulting from defects in material or workmanship.
